Please note that staff are not always present at the location.

Therefore, bike pick-up takes place between 9:00 a.m. and 9:15 a.m. and between 1:00 p.m. and 1:15 p.m. It is essential that you notify us if you will be late or if you wish to pick up the bikes at a different time.

Bikes must be returned between 1:00 PM and 1:45 PM and between 5:30 PM and 6:00 PM.

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SECURITY

Here are a few recommendations to help everyone ride safely :

- > Dress appropriately (avoid long dresses and baggy trousers).
- > Always obey the french road code and signs.
- > The bikes are designed for one person only; please respect this rule.
- > Ride on the road or dedicated lanes.
- > Do not take your phone in hand while riding the bike and do not use headphones.
- > We would also like to remind you that it is strictly forbidden to drink alcohol while cycling.



For the non-automatic bikes: it is important to change the gears one by one and slowly for the proper functioning of the e-bikes.

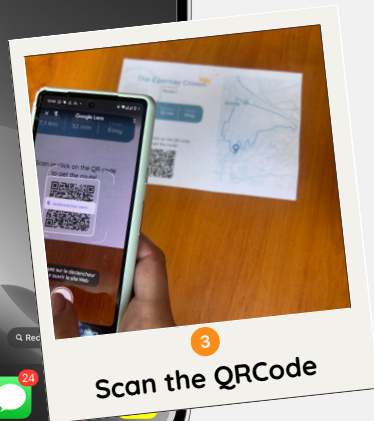
